National & State Security & Governance	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If arriving by air must produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours before their arrival or must test immediately upon arrival as directed by an authorised officer. If arriving by any other means must produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours before their arrival OR if unable to obtain a test or receive the result within that period, must complete COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine unless performing the duties, functions or activities of the category, or travelling to and from performing the duties, functions or activities for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA. From 11 October 2021 must produce evidence of having received at least 1 dose of TGA approved COVID-19 vaccine.
Emergency Services Workers	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA. From 11 October 2021 must produce evidence of having received at least 1 dose of TGA approved COVID-19 vaccine.
Commercial Transport and Freight Workers	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If arriving by road and rail must produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours before their arrival or undertake a point-of-care antigen based test and/or a COVID-19 test within 12hrs of entering the State of SA. If arriving by Air must produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours before their arrival or within 12 hours of arrival into SA. <i>This includes air crew who transit landside following a flight. It does not include aircrew who remain airside and do not enter the airport terminal.</i> If arriving by any other means must produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours before their arrival or within 24 hours of arrival into SA. Must not enter a high risk setting for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA. Commercial Transport and Freight Workers arriving by road must have evidence of at least one TGA approved COVID-19 vaccination. Category 1 - No self-quarantine Category 2 - Self-quarantine unless performing the duties, functions or activities of the category, travelling to and from performing the duties, functions or activities
Remote or Isolated Worker	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. People can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel. From 11 October 2021 must produce evidence of having received at least 1 dose of TGA approved COVID-19 vaccine.
Cross Border Community Members 70km side either side of the Victoria / South Australia border (excluding Portland)	Level 4 with conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Residents of SA and VIC living in the Cross Border Corridor (up to 70 km into Victoria or SA - excluding Portland) who remain within the Cross Border Corridor are subject to the following requirements: Must produce evidence of a COVID-19 test or a negative COVID-19 test result, within 7 days before their arrival or will need to undertake a COVID-19 test within 48hours of entering the State of SA. From 12.01am on 18 October 2021, people 18 years or above must produce evidence of having received at least 1 dose of TGA approved COVID-19 vaccine. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not required to self-quarantine. Must wear a mask while in public. Permitted purposes for travel: Employment or education, Providing care and support to or receiving care from another person or obtaining food, petrol or other fuel or medical care or supplies, Obtaining a COVID-19 vaccination, or Recreational or competitive sport. HOWEVER, a SA resident who travels further than the Cross Border Corridor into a restricted zone is not permitted to return unless they are a person escaping domestic violence with Level 5 requirements or have an exemption from SA Health. Note: People who wish to enter SA cannot associate with people who reside outside the corridor i.e. Portland.
	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you are a Cross Border Community Member who travels further than the Cross Border Corridor into Victoria you are: Not permitted to enter SA. Cross Border Community Members (and one carer) are permitted to travel to SA including beyond the cross border corridor solely for emergency health care for the management of conditions where the failure to do so quickly and safely will lead to loss of life, loss of limb and permanent disability. People can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel. From 12.01am on 18 October 2021 must produce evidence of having received at least 1 dose of TGA approved COVID-19 vaccine.
Specialist Workers in Essential Sectors	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. People can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel. From 11 October 2021 must produce evidence of having received at least 1 dose of TGA approved COVID-19 vaccine.
Passing Through	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. People can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel. From 11 October 2021 must produce evidence of having received at least 1 dose of TGA approved COVID-19 vaccine.
Foreign Diplomatic or Consular Staff	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If arriving by air must produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours before their arrival or must test immediately upon arrival as directed by an authorised officer. If arriving by any other means must produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours before their arrival OR if unable to obtain a test or receive the result within that period, must complete COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine unless performing the duties, functions or activities of the category, or travelling to and from performing the duties, functions or activities for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA. From 11 October 2021 must produce evidence of having received at least 1 dose of TGA approved COVID-19 vaccine.
