Emergency Management (Appropriate Surgery During COVID-19 Pandemic No 4) (Revocation) Direction 2020

under section 25 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004*

Preamble

- 1 On 22 March 2020 I, Grantley Stevens, Commissioner of Police, being State Co-ordinator for the State of South Australia pursuant to section 14 of the *Emergency Management Act 2004* (the *Act*), declared pursuant to section 23 of the Act that a Major Emergency is occurring in respect of the outbreak of the Human Disease named COVID-19 within South Australia.
- 2 Now I, Grantley Stevens, being of the opinion that this is necessary to achieve the purposes of the Act, give the following direction pursuant to section 25 of the Act.

1—Short title

This direction may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Appropriate Surgery During COVID-19 Pandemic No 4) (Revocation) Direction 2020*.

2—Purpose

The purpose of this direction is to revoke the *Emergency Management (Appropriate Surgery During COVID-19 Pandemic No 4) Direction 2020*.

3—Revocation of previous direction

The *Emergency Management (Appropriate Surgery During COVID-19 Pandemic No 4) Direction 2020* is revoked.

This direction operates from the 13th day of May 2020 at 2359 hours
