



Entry Requirements Chart

If South Australia declares that arrivals from a specified location, or a class of arrivals from a specified location, are subject to level 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 requirements, those arrivals, or class of arrivals, MUST comply with the requirements set out in the table below.

Level	Requirements
Level 1	<p>COVID-19 test within 24 hours after their arrival in South Australia.</p> <p>No entry to high risk setting until negative test: A person must not enter or remain in a high risk setting in South Australia for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia or until they get a negative COVID-19 test result unless the person is permitted to enter in accordance with clause 9 of <i>Cross Border Travel - General COVID-19 Direction 2021</i>.</p>
Level 2	<p>COVID-19 test within 24 hours after their arrival in South Australia, then on day 5 and 13.</p> <p>Quarantine until first test: A person must comply with the self-quarantine requirements under clause 10 of <i>Cross Border Travel - General COVID-19 Direction 2021</i> until they submit to the first COVID-19 test.</p> <p>No entry to high risk setting until negative test: A person must not enter or remain in a high risk setting in South Australia for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia or until they get a negative COVID-19 test result unless the person is permitted to enter in accordance with clause 9 of <i>Cross Border Travel - General COVID-19 Direction 2021</i>.</p>
Level 3	<p>COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13.</p> <p>Quarantine until negative test: A person must comply with the self-quarantine requirements under clause 10 of <i>Cross Border Travel - General COVID-19 Direction 2021</i> until they get a negative COVID-19 test result.</p> <p>No entry to high risk setting: A person must not enter or remain in a high risk setting in SA for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA unless the person is permitted to enter in accordance with clause 9 of <i>Cross Border Travel - General COVID-19 Direction 2021</i>.</p> <p>No entry to COVID Management Plan events: A person must not attend any event in South Australia with an approved COVID Management Plan or at which more than 1000 people are present for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.</p>
Level 4	<p>COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13.</p> <p>Self-quarantine: A person must comply with the self-quarantine requirements under clause 10 for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia</p> <p>Mask in public: A person must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.</p>
Level 5	<p>COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13.</p> <p>Quarantine as directed: a person must reside and remain, quarantined and segregated from other persons, at a place determined by an authorised officer for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia</p> <p>Mask in public: A person must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.</p>
Level 6	<p>Prohibition on entry: A person must not enter South Australia.</p>
