People arriving from ACT or NSW in the last 14 days

SA residents, People Passing Through SA, Specialist Workers & Remote or Isolated Workers who have been in ACT/NSW	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. SA Residents, Specialist Workers and Remote or Isolated Workers or those relocating to SA can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel.
People escaping Domestic Violence who have been in ACT/NSW	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine at a place determined by an authorised officer for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.
Essential Travellers (excluding Specialist Workers & Remote / Isolated Workers)	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please refer to the Essential traveller Table for more information.
Commonwealth MPs & their staff who have been in ACT	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.

People arriving from Victoria in the last 14 days

Any person who has been in Vic (including Returning SA Residents, People Passing Through SA & Genuine Relocations)	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. SA Residents or those relocating to SA can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel.
People escaping Domestic Violence who have been in Vic	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine at a place determined by an authorised officer for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.
Essential Travellers	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please refer to the Essential traveller Table for more information.

People arriving from Northern Territory

Unvaccinated Travellers & Essential Travellers (excluding CTFS) who have been in NT since 10 November	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. Travellers or Essential Travellers can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel.
Fully Vaccinated non-SA Residents who have been in NT since 10 November	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter SA. Travellers or Essential Travellers can apply to SA Health for exemption and must receive approval from SA Health before travel.
People who are escaping Domestic Violence	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine at a place determined by an authorised officer for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.
Unvaccinated Returning SA Residents who have been in NT since 10 November	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.
All fully Vaccinated SA Travellers* who have been in Katherine LGA since 10 November	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine for 7 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA.
All fully Vaccinated SA Travellers* who have been in NT (but not in Katherine LGA) since 10 November	Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine until negative test. No entry into high risk setting for 14 days after arrival, unless clause 9 applies. No entry to COVID Management Plan events >1000.
Commercial Transport & Freight Services (CTFS) Travellers	Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please refer to the Essential traveller Table for more information.

*Note: People are travelling with children under 12 years and 1 month – the children will have the vaccination status of the parents/guardians/adults.

People arriving from Queensland, Tasmania or Western Australia

People arriving from QLD, TAS or WA	No Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People who are arriving from Queensland, Tasmania, or Western Australia are not subject to any restrictions upon entering SA, provided they have not been in a restricted zone in the 14 days prior to entering SA.

Overseas Arrivals

Overseas Arrivals into Adelaide or via Sydney or Melbourne	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine as directed. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in SA. NOTE: New South Wales and Victoria do not require overseas arrivals to complete 14 days quarantine, SA does.
